Description of Collection and Treatment System:
The City of Bessemer City has over 50 miles of piping in its sewer collection system, ranging in size from 4" to 15", ranging in age from less than 1 year to 86 years. Also included in this system are 9 sewage lift stations of various sizes ranging in age from 10 years to 41 years. The Public Works Department is constantly changing, replacing, and upgrading its sewer collection system, as well as continually working to improve the sewage pumping stations.

Bessemer City's Waste Water Treatment is accomplished by the City of Gastonia at its Crowders Creek Waste Water Treatment Facility NPDES Permit# NC0074268. We are permitted by the City of Gastonia to discharge a total of 1.609 Million gallons per day of wastewater.

The overall performance of Bessemer City's collection system has been good over the period.
