Pennsylvania Avenue was approved.

Mayor Smith opened the floor for Council general discussion. Council congratulated Councilman Dan Boling on a recent birthday. Council member Dan Boling commended the Bessemer City Police Department on their dedication and hard work. Council member Kay McCathen mentioned some citizens had complaints about the Vantine Cemetery gate. City Manager Inman took the initiative to seek the matter further. Councilmember Howard Jones mentioned that he would be interested in Council creating a Purple Heart Lane, similar to the one in the Bessemer City Memorial, for the Vantine Cemetery. City Attorney, David Smith and City Planner, Jeffrey Kirchner provided an update on the Hotel property progress.
