Bessemer City Granted \$2,150,000 for Capital Improvements for Police and Fire (Public Safety)

Bessemer City has been granted \$2,150,000 from the State of North Carolina, as part of the State Budget, for public safety improvements. The City is currently conducting a feasibility study that will identify current and future public safety needs in the community, i.e. fire, police, etc. This study is focused on facility needs as the City continues to invest in a full-service fire department and as the police department grows.

In October 2023, Mayor Smith, City Council, City Manager, Josh Ross, Public Safety Director/Police Chief, Tom Ellis, and Fire Chief, Brent Gordon thanked local legislators for their advocacy and effort to include funding for Bessemer City in the State Budget. State Senator Brad Overcash and State Representative Kelly Hastings continue to advocate for Bessemer City's interests and needs. We are also thankful for House Speaker Tim Moore's support for Bessemer City!

Bessemer City is committed to providing quality public safety services to citizens and businesses for current and future growth.

General Reminders from the City

Utility Payments: Utility bills are due the 10th of each month. Late fees are assessed on the 11th (15%) and utility cut off occurs after the 19th of the month. The City provides multiple options for utility payment:

In-Person: cash, check, debit and credit (note- 3% merchant fee applies for debit and credit payments) are accepted at the City Hall Annex during business hours (M-F 8am-12:30 pm & 1:30pm-5:00pm)

Drop Box: cash, money order, and checks can be placed in the night-drop box outside of City Hall Annex. Please include account number and address with payment.

<u>Drive-Thru:</u> cash, check, money orders and credit payments can be accepted at the City Hall Annex drive-thru during business hours (M-F 8am-12:30 pm & 1:30 pm-5pm)

Online Bill Pay: debit and credit payments are accepted through our online bill pay system (\$2 + 3% merchant fee). Visit us online at www.bessemercity.com for details.

ACH Draft Payments: setup automatic ACH payments with your financial institution with the City. The City and its third-party administrator does not charge for this service.

Code Enforcement: The City's Code Enforcement Division works diligently to address all code violations in accordance to local ordinances and North Carolina General Statutes (NCGS). To report a violation, please call (704) 629-5542 and selection option 4.

Garbage & Debris Collection:

Garbage

- *Bag all garbage before placing in cart (this prevents litter).
- *Only bags placed inside garbage cart will be picked up.

Bulky Items

- *Items too large to fit inside your garbage cart are bulky items (such as furniture, mattresses, etc.).
- *Bulky items are picked up weekly on your normal service
- *Place bulky items beside cart.
- *No electronics or appliances.

Yard Waste Collection

- *The City will pick up yard waste weekly usually on your normal service day.
- *Branches must be no more than 6 inches in diameter and less than 5 feet long.
- *Do not mix other debris with leaves.
- *Loose leaves will be collected from October 1 March 1.
- *Bagged leaves will be collected March 2 September 30.
- *Limb Collection Reminder City Ordinances require that limbs be no longer than 5ft. in length, and no larger than 6 inches in diameter. We cannot collect limbs if other debris is mixed with them, or if they exceed the required length & size. We are seeing an increase in contracted work being placed at curbside for collection. We do not collect yard waste resulting from any type of contracted work.

Kintegra Health: 10,000 square foot medical (medical, dental, and pharmacy) complex along E. Virginia Ave. Project is currently under construction.

Foundry Commercial: 280,000 square foot industrial project has been completed and awarded a Certificate of Occupancy (C.O.). This space is currently being marketed for lease.

Edgewood 85 Commerce Park: a 1,000,000 square foot industrial park scheduled to start in 2024 located off of Edgewood Road in Bessemer City.


Lennar Homes: a 162 unit single family home project located off Costner School Road. The site is currently being graded and infrastructure install is scheduled to start in 2024.

Development Spotlight: The Lofts at Osage Mill

The Lofts at Osage Mill: Development continues on the restoration of the Historic Osage Mill in Bessemer City. This private investment serves as a catalyst for new growth, small business development, and historic preservation in Bessemer City. Osage Mill was built in the late 1800s (1896) by the City's founder, John Smith.

The Lofts at Osage Mill will provide a new diverse living experience in Bessemer City. Walls that once employed hundreds of workers will soon house hundreds of residents. A portion of units are expected to be finished summer 2024, with the remaining units finishing in 2025. Approximately 20,000 square feet of the mill (facing Alabama Avenue) is planned for future commercial development.
